

## Board of Governors Action Items October 24, 2019

Approved the results of the July 2019 bar exam.

Approved 6 reciprocity applicants and 3 UBE score transfer applicants for admission.

Approve the 2020 budget, keeping bar dues at the same level it has been since 2012 (\$660).

Voted to move \$100,000 from unappropriated capital to the long term capital reserve.

Voted to amend Bylaw VI, section 1 to state that officers take office at the close of the annual business meeting at which they have been elected and serve until the close of the next annual business meeting.

Added a section to the Standing Policies of the Board of Governors to provide that committee members may be removed after three unexcused absences, or after excessive unexcused absences as determined by the committee chair.

Voted to adopt the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of the Area Hearing Committee in regarding the Reinstatement Matter of Dawn Austin, and to recommend her reinstatement to the Supreme Court.

Voted to accept a stipulation in the matter of Attorney B, providing for an 18 month suspension and for the attorney to be supervised for 12 months after resuming practice, to do nine hours of ethics CLE and pay \$1,000 in costs.

Voted to adopt the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of the Area Hearing Committee involving the discipline matter of Erin Gonzalez-Powell, recommending her disbarment to the Supreme Court.

Voted to accept the minutes of the September board meeting as modified.

Voted to appoint Stephanie White Thorn as the ABA Delegate.
