## Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection - \$10 fee included with dues

Active Status Only - This fund is created for the purpose of reimbursing clients who have suffered non-insured losses of money or things of value as a result of dishonest conduct by attorneys. Bar Association Bylaw Article III, Section 1 (a) mandates that all active members must pay \$10 annually to the Fund. Bar Rule 61 provides that a member may be suspended for failure to pay this fee.

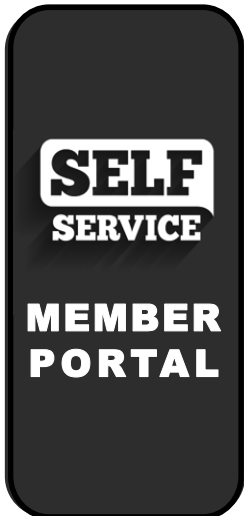
## Alaska Legal Services Corporation
