Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection - \$10 fee included with dues

Active Status Only - This fund is created for the purpose of reimbursing clients who have suffered non-insured losses of money or things of value as a result of dishonest conduct by attorneys. Bar Association Bylaw Article III, Section 1 (a) mandates that all active members must pay \$10 annually to the Fund. Bar Rule 61 provides that a member may be suspended for failure to pay this fee.

Late Fee Notice!

ALL PAYMENTS made AFTER July 1, 2020 will result in a LATE FEE of \$10 per week. Include this fee in your payment with each portion of a week considered a whole week.

Suspension - Members who do not pay their dues or late fees will have their license suspended. On August 1, members will be given notice that on approximately September 1, a petition will be filed with the Supreme Court requesting that the members who have not paid their bar dues or late fees will have their license suspended.
