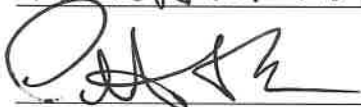

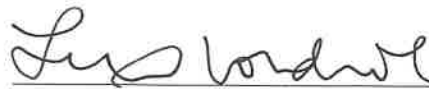
I attended The George Washington University Law School from August 2022-May 2025. During law school, I interned at Equal Justice Under Law, a nonprofit organization that brings class action lawsuits aimed at reforming systemic inequalities in our justice system, where I wrote about debtors' prisons for their blog. I also interned at the National Center for Protection Orders on Full Faith and Credit within the Battered Women's Justice Project, contributing to their resource library, and served as a Womenslaw.org email hotline volunteer within the National Network to End Domestic Violence.

Before law school, I worked in trucking. I developed an owner operator program, then a lease purchase program, and served as head of department, recruiting and retaining commercial truck drivers for a fleet of 35 trucks. Prior to trucking, I was a financial advisor, FINRA Series 7-licensed, at North Star Resource Group, where I developed a women's division and wrote the curriculum for the intern training program.

I attended the University of Texas at Austin from August 2013-May 2017, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree and a European Studies Certificate, with majors in History, French, and Government. Education access and empowering others through education are my driving forces.
