Thus, *each member if a law firm* (where applicable) *must complete and submit a NOE* even if each such member shares in the use of the same trust account, interest-bearing or not.
- 2. Participants in the Alaska IOLTA program need only have one IOLTA account. Participants need not convert each of their client trust accounts, should they have more than one.
