My name is Nick Ostrovsky. I was born and raised in Anchorage, Alaska, have been a member of the bar since 2014, and currently serve as general counsel for a large Alaska Native corporation. I am the president-elect of the Board of Governors and am running for re-election after my first term.

During my first term, the Board has been productive. Among our many accomplishments, we paid off the Bar's building and kept dues level despite rising costs. We pushed through a rule change to streamline admission-on-motion and temporary-practice waivers for legal-aid providers, making it easier for qualified public-interest attorneys to serve low-income Alaskans. We also adopted a new three-year strategic plan for 2026–2028, focused on increasing access to qualified attorneys in rural and underserved communities, strengthening member engagement, and supporting the mental health and well-being of Alaska lawyers.

I also serve on the Lawyers Assistance Committee, which provides confidential support to attorneys struggling with mental health and substance-use issues. This work matters deeply to me and informs many of the decisions I am called to make as a member of the Board of Governors.

I want to continue this work and build on what we've accomplished. Thank you for your support.
