The Alaska Bar Association has moved for an order of interim suspension under Alaska Bar Rule 26(e) against Attorney Justin Facey. In the alternative, Bar Counsel requests an administrative suspension under Bar Rules 22(a) and 61(e) for Facey's failure to answer grievance investigations. Attorney Facey filed a response two days later pointing out that grievance investigation responses had been submitted, and requesting a 90-day stay on any disciplinary action to allow time to negotiate a resolution with Bar Counsel and responsibly wind down his law practice. On consideration of the motion and response,

IT IS ORDERED:

The Motion for Interim Disciplinary Suspension under Bar Rule 26(e) is **GRANTED**. Bar Counsel has demonstrated that Attorney Facey's conduct constitutes a substantial threat of irreparable harm to his clients or prospective clients. Attorney Facey is suspended from the practice of law in Alaska, effective immediately, until further order of this Court.
