Re: Lawyer Representative to the Ninth Circuit Judicial Conference

The Alaska Bar Association is soliciting names for a lawyer representative to serve a three year term to the 9th Circuit Judicial Conference. The term of Bryan Schroder and Danée L. Pontious will expire on September 30, 2024. However, there is only one vacancy because one of the vacancies was already filled via an interim appointment.

Lawyer representatives work to foster open communications between federal judges and attorneys, and provide support and advice in the functioning of the court. Lawyer representatives sit on various court committees, help plan and present the local District Conferences, and serve as a liaison between the federal bench and the practicing bar. Applicants should have some regular practice in federal court.

Representatives are expected to attend the Ninth Circuit Conference in the summer. The U.S. District Court for Alaska will contribute a portion of the lawyer representative's cost to attend the Ninth Circuit Conference, up to \$2,000, upon request.

There will be no bar poll. Interested lawyers are asked to submit a resume and letter of interest. The Bar Association will collect the resumes and letters of interest and forward them on to the Court. The Court makes the actual selection.
